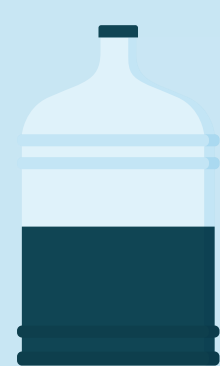

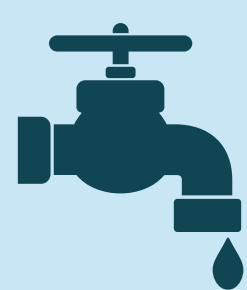


Fixing leaks can save you up to
